The School Teachers' Review Body (STRB) recommended that no pay uplift be applied to the maximum values on the Leadership Group Pay Spine (LGPS) or to maximum values on any of the eight headteacher group pay ranges in 2015.

This restriction was applied to the maximum of each of the eight headteacher group pay ranges only. It does not apply where a head/deputy/assistant headteacher is not earning the maximum on a headteacher group pay range, but is placed on one of the corresponding points on the LCPS - L18, L21, L24, L27, L31, L35 or L39, which have all increased by 1% in each year between 2014 and 2017, by 1.5% in 2018, by 2.75% in both 2019 and 2020, by 1.75% in 2021, by 6.5% in 2022, by 5% in 2023, and by 5.5% in 2024. The NASUWT salary scales above are entirely consistent with those published by the Welsh Government for 2024. They incorporate the 5.5% pay uplift, which has been accepted by the Welsh Government.
