FURTHER EDUCATION LECTURERS' NEGOTIATING COMMITTEE

Further Education Lecturers' Pay award from 01 September 2024 and 01 September 2025

In accordance with the provisions of Article 11, Schedule 3, paragraph 10.3 of the Further Education (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 the Constitution for Negotiating the Terms, Conditions of Service and Remuneration of Lecturers' Employed in Colleges of Further Education, it has been determined that from 01 September 2024 and 01 September 2025, the rates of salaries and allowances to be paid to Lecturers in Colleges of Further Education shall be those set out in the Appendix 1 to this Circular.

Summary of Changes:

1. 5.5% increase on each salary scale point and allowance from 01 September 2024 relating to Lecturer's Contract of Employment (i.e. Associate Lecturers, Full-Time Lecturers, Principal Lecturers and Heads of Department) and Part-time Hourly Paid Lecturers.
2. 5.5% increase to allowances i.e. Threshold, Deane, Responsibility and Re-organisation) from 01 September 2024 relating to Lecturer's Contract of Employment (i.e. Associate Lecturers, Full-Time Lecturers, Principal Lecturers and Heads of Department).
3. 3% increase on each salary scale point and allowance from 01 September 2025 relating to Lecturer's Contract of Employment (i.e. Associate Lecturers, Full-Time Lecturers, Principal Lecturers and Heads of Department) and Part-time Hourly Paid Lecturers.
4. 3% increase to allowances i.e. Threshold, Deane, Responsibility and Re-organisation) from 01 September 2025 relating to Lecturer's Contract of Employment (i.e. Associate Lecturers, Full-Time Lecturers, Principal Lecturers and Heads of Department).

5. Approval for incremental increases due 01 September 2025.

5 Payment of Part-time Hourly-Paid Teachers

6 Deane Agreement

01 September 2024

- 6.1 All Lecturers who have been on the threshold pay point for at least two years (at 01 September 2024) will receive a further award of £1,684 from 01 September 2024. This award will be consolidated and pensionable.
- 6.2 All Lecturers who move on to the threshold point (at 01 September 2024) will receive a further award of £1,684 (or the relevant figure at that point in time), on completion of two years' service on the threshold pay point.

01 September 2025

- 6.3 All Lecturers who have been on the threshold pay point for at least two years (at 1 September 2025) will receive a further award of £1,735 from 01 September 2025. This award will be consolidated and pensionable.
- 6.4 All Lecturers who move on to the threshold point (at 01 September 2025) will receive a further award of £1735 (or the relevant figure at that point in time), on completion of two years' service on the threshold pay point.

7 Responsibility Allowances

- 7.1 Under the Deane Agreement, it was agreed that a system of responsibility allowances could be introduced on a college by college basis, concurrent with the phasing out of the Senior Lecturer grade. Allowances are permanent or flexible. The permanent allowances are pensionable and consolidated whilst the flexible allowances are non-consolidated. One responsibility allowance will be valued at £2,016 from 01 September 2024 and £2,076 from 01 September 2025.

8 Re-organisation Allowance

- 8.1 Where a lecturer in a further education college is in receipt of a reorganisation allowance in accordance with the provisions of Department of Education Circular 1996/1, the value of that allowance should be uplifted by 5.5% from 01 September 2024 and 3% from 01 September 2025.
