### Dear Colleague

We're pleased to enclose your updated NASUWT noticeboard pack – a practical tool to help you keep your union noticeboard clear, eye-catching and up to date.

A well-maintained NASUWT noticeboard is more than just a display – it's a vital way to:

- demonstrate the Union's presence and activity in your workplace;
- support recruitment and organisation by showing members and potential members that their union is active and effective; and
- keep colleagues informed about NASUWT's work locally, regionally and nationally.

Throughout the year, the Union produces a wide range of materials you can use to refresh your display and engage members. This pack includes key resources you can tailor to your setting and update as needed.

While there is no statutory right to facilities for union representatives (except in specific cases such as collective redundancies and TUPE), NASUWT has successfully negotiated access to noticeboards with most employers. Acas guidance also makes clear that employers should, where practical, provide union representatives with facilities that support effective communication with members and officers.

This leaflet includes suggestions on how to use the contents.

## WHAT'S IN THE NOTICEBOARD PACK?

**This pack contains an assortment of the following items for your noticeboards:**

### **Starting Out?**

Display this to encourage more colleagues to get involved in the Union.



### **Undiluted Voice**

Display this to tell colleagues that we are the authentic voice of the profession.

### **Join your NASUWT Workplace Team**

Display this on the NASUWT noticeboard to show colleagues the support and training available from being part of the Union team.

### **Union Meeting Poster**

Display this to publicise to members in your workplace NASUWT meetings being held either in the workplace or called by the NASUWT Local Association.

### **Workplace Representative/Contact Details**

Most NASUWT workplaces have an accredited NASUWT Representative.

Some workplaces have an NASUWT contact who will support members by passing on information.

Display these so that members and those interested in joining NASUWT know who to contact in the workplace.



### **Health & Safety Representative**

Most workplaces have NASUWT Health & Safety Representatives who help to improve the working lives of teachers. Display this so members know who to contact to tackle the physical, environmental and organisational factors that affect your wellbeing.

### **Learning Representative**

Display this so colleagues can contact the Union activist who will best support their professional development in the workplace.
