

OVERWHELMING SUPPORT FOR INDUSTRIAL ACTION

Dear Member

Thank you very much for participating in the recent ballot for industrial action conducted by the NASUWT.

The ballot has resulted in overwhelming support of members for industrial action, including strike action.

The ballot result is as follows:

61.1% turnout of members, with 84.4% voting in favour of strike action and 89% in favour of action short of strike action.

We will be notifying the Gibraltar Government of the result today, making clear that the NASUWT remains committed to a negotiated settlement and asking them genuinely to engage in constructive negotiations.

There is no doubt that members have demonstrated their deep concerns about the current position through the strong ballot result and placed the ball firmly in the Government's court to return to the Union to engage in negotiations.

We will keep members updated on the Government's response and on progress.

At the present time, no notice of industrial action is being given. However, should progress not be made in the negotiations, that position may change and we will then contact members again.
