

NASUWT – Here for you

We know that sometimes teachers experience financial hardship. Members are eligible to apply to the NASUWT Benevolence Fund. Dependants of a member may also be eligible for support.

Legal Protection

In addition to the Union's employment-related services, through partners, we offer a complete legal package for you and your dependants, which includes:

- a 30-minute free legal advice service staffed by experienced advisors to advise on any non-employment legal issues (e.g. noisy neighbours, faulty goods, holiday that went wrong);
- a free personal injury service for you and your dependants covering any non-work-related injury, disease or illness caused by someone else provided the claim can be pursued in the UK courts;
- a free road traffic accident scheme if you or one of your dependants is injured in an accident on the roads;
- a free will-writing service for you and a reduced cost will-writing service for family members; and
- a low fixed-fee conveyancing package for you and your dependants.

Insurance

We also provide for you the following insurance cover:

- fire and theft – for loss or damage of personal property on school premises;
- malicious damage to cars – on school premises;
- personal accident – whilst engaged in workplace/school activities, including commuting;
- public liability – in the event that members are held legally liable for an injury or damage whilst engaged in teaching activities.


