

Pay

The NASUWT has recently submitted a pay claim in respect of 2017 to the States Employment Board (SEB). The claim provides clear and unequivocal evidence of the need for a substantial uplift to teachers' pay, which has been eroded over the last decade, with a cumulative loss of nearly £20,000 for some teachers.

The pay claim submitted can be found at www.nasuwt.org.uk/jersey. The Union is currently awaiting the response of the SEB.

Education Partnership

The Education Partnership has released a note on the School Assessment Framework, which is available on the Jersey section of the NASUWT website and gov.je/educationpartnership.

Pilot-school reviews have been carried out under the new Framework, and the Partnership will evaluate the scheme to ensure poor practice from systems such as Ofsted in England is avoided.

Recent NASUWT Successes

A strong response from the NASUWT at Victoria College prevented a six-period day being enacted without proper consultation with the Union. The NASUWT was the only union to oppose the changes, with other unions proposing to consult over which six-period model to adopt.

Following negotiations initiated by the NASUWT, the Union has also secured a reduction in contact hours at Haute Vallée school by 1.5 hours per week.
