

PAY UPDATE

There has been little progress on the pay award for 2019/20.

NASUWT negotiators met with State representatives recently. However, the Policy and Resources Committee (P&RC) has not met to discuss the Union's response to the pay offer of 2.3%. The P&RC is expected to meet towards the end of the month, and more details should be available then.

States Public Service Employees (manual workers) have decided to take their pay claim to the Tribunal for a binding decision.

The NASUWT is monitoring the progress of this claim closely, as it could impact on the pay award for teachers.

SCHOOL REORGANISATION

The NASUWT is becoming increasingly concerned that the Education Department is presenting plans for the reorganised secondary schools, including lengthening the school day and the introduction of enrichment as a fait accompli.

The NASUWT has raised concerns about this with P&RC representatives, as this would involve a change to terms and conditions of employment and as such, is not within the Education Department's remit.

Teachers are employed by the P&RC, and not by the Education Department, and changes to terms and conditions can only be done through the Teacher and Lecturers Joint Council (TLJC), which has not considered proposals or any contractual changes for teachers.

Additionally, although the NASUWT is committed to working with the States on the matter of the school reorganisation, nothing has yet been formally agreed with the NASUWT, and talks continue on numerous issues and work streams.
