

PAY DISPUTE UPDATE

The NASUWT met with representatives of the States Employment Board (SEB) on 1 April 2019 to discuss the ongoing dispute and explore any possible route to resolution.

The Union was very clear with the SEB of the need for the States to move on the 2018/19 imposed pay awards.

Whilst there was no movement achieved at that meeting, the SEB will consider further its position in relation to teachers' pay later in the month, pending discussions with other pay groups.

In the meantime, the SEB is aware of the strength and solidarity of members and that there will be full support of members for the action short of strike action instruction on no cover for absence which will take effect on 23 April.

The NASUWT has ensured that the SEB is fully aware of the consequences of failing to appreciate the anger of teachers, including that plans for further action are being laid if there is no positive response from the SEB.
