

The Eamonn O'Kane Young Activist of the Year Award 2021

GUIDANCE NOTES

The Award

The Young Activist of the Year Award was created to:

- encourage activism amongst young members;
- recognise and celebrate the outstanding contribution of young members to the work of the NASUWT;
- provide award winners with opportunities to broaden and develop their knowledge and experience of the NASUWT and the wider trade union movement.

Eligibility

The nominee shall be aged 29 years or under at the time of receiving the award at the NASUWT Annual Conference, (2-5 April 2021). The award will not be made to any member with outstanding arrears on their membership account.

Criteria

The nominee will have been successful in one or more of the areas listed below:

- heightened the NASUWT's profile;
- promoted the work of the NASUWT;
- increased the membership of the NASUWT;
- organised members in a workplace or wider constituency;
- promoted trade union activism in a workplace or wider constituency;
- delivered identifiable benefits to members and/or the NASUWT as an organisation.

The activities that achieved these outcomes may include:

- representation;
- negotiation;
- campaigning;
- organising or engaging members.

Nomination Process

Nominations must be submitted on the official nomination form and supported by a National Executive Member. Nomination forms can be obtained from NASUWT Headquarters or Regional/National Centres or downloaded at: www.nasuwt.org.uk/youngactivist.

Closing Date

The closing date for nominations will be 8 February 2021.
