

NASUWT MEMBERS SEND CLEAR MESSAGE IN ACTION BALLOT

The NASUWT's ballot for industrial action in furtherance of the Union's trade dispute with the States of Jersey over pay has been a resounding success.

In a ballot return where over two thirds of Union members voted, almost 95% of members returning their ballots voted for strike action and action short of strike action.

Members have demonstrated through the ballot their anger at the way teachers and lecturers are being treated over their pay and that they will not tolerate yet another round of real terms pay cuts.

This is the result of a decade of year-on-year deterioration in pay which has undermined the competitiveness of teacher and lecturer salaries and has adversely impacted on their living standards.

The States Employment Board (SEB) needs to heed the clear message NASUWT members are sending and come to the table for meaningful talks.

The NASUWT thanks all members who participated in the ballot. The results have been sent to the SEB and now, with a clear mandate from members, the Union will be planning the next steps in the pay campaign.
